> Current compliance challenges

Three types of business licenses

A one-stop shop for your end-to-end international compliance needs





Business Licenses

Issued by the government to grant permission to conduct operations within their borders.



Permits

Certifies that safety and health requirements are met, generally issued for a physical site or a specific parcel of land.



Tax Registrations

First step the government requires to begin collecting taxes from a business.

Business license compliance is challenging

There are **50** states, **3,000** counties, and over **35,000** municipalities in the United States.

Each one of these can set and enforce their business license requirements. Maintaining compliance in all these jurisdictions takes time, resources, and money.



Different Requirements

Different jurisdiction, different licensing requirements



Changing Requirements

- Any jurisdiction can change their requirements at any time
- Notice is not guaranteed



Different Processes

- Online vs manual submission
- Different timing
- Different payment methods



Impacts of Business Changes

Any change to your business can impact your business licenses: **new locations, new products, new officers**

Real vs. personal property tax



Real property

- Land (e.g. golf courses or parking lots)
- Buildings (e.g. warehouses or hotels)



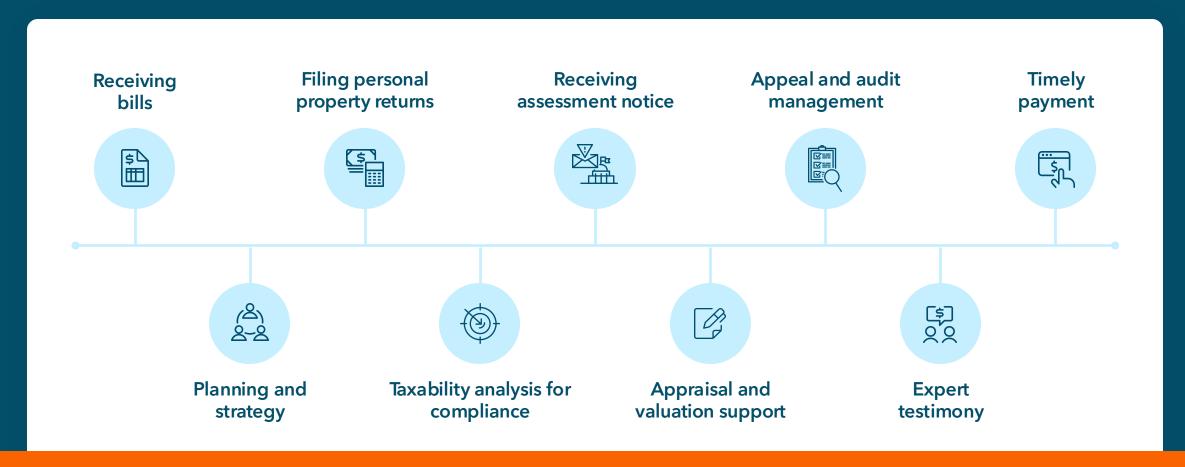
Personal property (movable assets)

- Machinery
- Computers
- Supplies
- Copiers

- Tools
- Furnishing or shelving
- PoS devices

- Equipment
- Medical devices
- Etc.

The property tax compliance cycle



Amidst all these necessary processes, there are different rules and regulations in every jurisdiction.

Business events like M&A, expansion, etc... add complexity.

Possible consequences for property tax non-compliance



Costly Penalties

Late or inaccurate filings can result in financial penalties.

Overpayment **Due to Errors**

Misreporting asset values or classifications can lead to paying more than necessary.

Resource Drain

Employee burnout and dissatisfaction due to constant corrections from inadequate tools.

Operational Disruption

Tax liens or disputes with assessors can affect business operations, credit ratings, or asset management.

Missed Appeal Opportunities

Without timely review of assessments, businesses may miss their opportunity to dispute overvalued property taxes.



Possible consequences for business license non-compliance



Jurisdictions may impose significant monetary penalties for operating without the proper licenses or for late renewals.

Business Disruption

Authorities can suspend or revoke licenses, leading to temporary shutdowns or inability to operate in certain areas.

Delayed Expansion

Missing or incomplete licensing can delay store openings, product launches, or entry into new markets.

Reputational **Damage**

Non-compliance can erode trust with customers, partners, and regulators.

Resource Drain

Resolving compliance issues often diverts time and resources away from strategic initiatives.

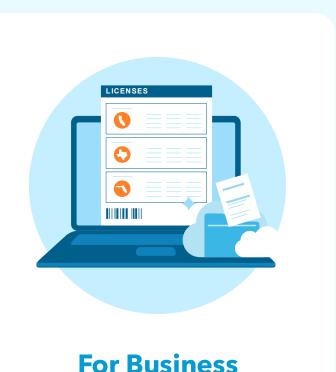

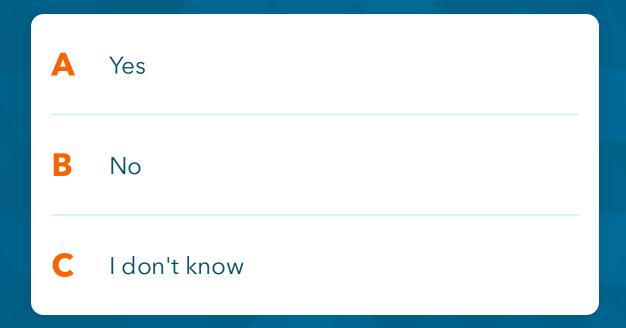
